- 1. There were 7 attendees. There were apologies from Mr & Mrs Clegg, Mr & Mrs M Hope, S Hope, T Warner, B Coles.
- 2. Minutes of previous meeting Tuesday 19th November 2019 read and accepted.
- 3. There were no matters arising.
- 4. Mr Meath Baker gave the Chair's report.
- 5. Reports/updates from: Footpaths walkers encouraged to continue cutting undergrowth at stiles and gates. Jubilee Wood report sent: "Growing well. It is always a pleasure to visit the wood, to have a picnic while seated at the picnic table and enjoying the surroundings." Flower Festival 2021 uncertainty due to other local villages' plans as some of the flower arrangers work with more than one festival; First Aid course due to Covid-19 it would be impossible to engage in any practical instruction so assume this will have to be postponed until next year, 2021, when the situation hopefully resolves. Police people should contact 101 if there is any concern about suspicious activity. Reported offences rose locally during lockdown. Hasfield had 1 offence in June.

 - 2. Grit bins: Brendon Coles & Doug Miles to check for siting and number. 100 litre bins are available for £100. BC & DM to follow-up emails to Gloucestershire Highways to see if they can be supplied supply them. If Highways prove unhelpful the meeting agreed to allocate some funds.
 - 3. Alleged unauthorised construction of building refused through application 13/01058/FUL at Bragmans Croft, Great House Lane, Hasfield GL19 4LQ JMB to follow up.
 - 4. Richard Barter, Lime Kiln Farm, has a farm shop and cooked food business. The change-of-use was queried, but the regulations have been relaxed during Covid-19. He has applied for an alcohol licence. The meeting wasn't against this. JMB to follow up
 - 5. Parking layby to be made on verge near postbox in Lower Hasfield for use by those who have inaccessible houses during flood time. DM to follow up with Highways. Rachel Hope has offered help with resources. The meeting agreed to fund costs if necessary.
